McHenry County College will notify the bidder whose bid is the subject of the bid protest of evidence presented in the bid protest and evidence found as a result of the investigation, and, if deemed appropriate, afford bidder an opportunity to rebut such evidence, and permit the bidder to present evidence that it should be allowed to perform the work. If deemed appropriate by McHenry County College, an informal hearing will be held. McHenry County College will issue a written decision within 15 days following receipt of the bid protest, unless factors beyond McHenry County College reasonable control prevent such a resolution, in which event such decision will be issued as expeditiously as circumstances reasonably permit. The decision will state the reasons for the action taken by McHenry County College. A copy of the decision will be furnished to the protestor, the bidder whose bid is the subject of the bid protest, and all bidders affected by the decision.
