CONSTRUCTION/FLAGGER

Flagger Certification

The National Safety Council (NSC) Work Zone Flagger Program incorporates classroom instruction, hands-on training and a flagging skills test to teach roadway personnel how to minimize confusion with standard flagging procedures and provide safe passage of traffic through and around Temporary Traffic Control Work Zones. This four-hour NSC Certification program meets federal industry guidelines and includes a manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. This certificate is valid for three years. Participants will learn: key flagging procedures, critical do's and don'ts for flaggers, and how to maintain safety for themselves, roadway users, and their crew.

FIRE SERVICE

Fire Apparatus Engineer

This course provides students with the basic knowledge and skills needed to perform as professional fire apparatus engineers. Classroom hours and an extra day of hands-on scenarios build the confidence and repetition that no pump operator should be without! There will be a blended learning component built into the course. For state certification, students are required to: Be certified as a Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter, pass the OSFM written exam (which will be scheduled in class), and complete a driving practical with the student's employing fire department. 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Firefighter Rope Operations

This course exceeds the requirements outlined by the Illinois Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) and provides students with the basic knowledge and skills needed to perform basic rope rescue at the NFPA 1670 & 1006 Operations level. Students will leave prepared to operate as members of a team where basic rope rescue may be needed. This course covers the use of rope, rope equipment, hardware, construction of mechanical advantage systems, belay and safety systems, anchor systems, patient packaging, self-rescue, and vertical rescue litter handling techniques. Required Textbook: *High Angle Rope Rescue Techniques Levels I & II*, 4th edition, 2016, Tom Vines & Steve Hudson, Jones & Bartlett Publishing, ISBN: 9781284136159. Pre-Requisites: OSFM Certified Firefighter II or Basic Operations. FF Students to provide: SRT Helmet, SRT Gloves, boots w/steel toe and class 3 harness.

This important course is a co-requisite for Advanced Technician Firefighter Certification. Student must be on fire department roster with OSFM to enroll in class. The student must meet all OSFM attendance requirements to sit for final exams. McHenry County College will register students to take final OSFM written exam. Required Textbook: *Vehicle Rescue and Extrication*, 2nd edition, Ron Moore, ISBN: 9780323018333. Pre-Requisites: OSFM Certified Firefighter II or Basic Operations FF. Equipment: NFPA compliant PPE w/eye protection and gloves.

There is no guarantee of passing any one skill, although the student will be given every opportunity to succeed. Testing will be done by an Illinois Department of Public Health approved instructor.
