# **Early Arrival/Late Departure Options**

The Kids and College Program will be offering early arrival and late departure options for Summer 2025. Campers must register for each option to participate. Early arrival begins at 7:30 a.m. and late departure ends at 5:30 p.m. Campers must be picked up by 5:30 p.m.

#### Lunch

A supervised lunch period from 12 to 1 p.m. will be available for campers who participate in either an all-day class or two classes on the same day (morning and afternoon). Campers are required to bring a healthy, nut-free sack lunch. More information will be provided in the Camper's Guide.


