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Chamberlain College of Nursing offers the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree program at three Illinois locations: Addison, Chicago and Tinley Park. Chamberlain College of Nursing is accredited by The Higher Learning Commission (HLC) and is a member of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The BS and MS in Nursing degree programs are accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

### Application and Admission Information

- **Application** - New students are admitted six times per year: January, March, May, July, September and November. Apply early to allow time for processing your application. Recommendation is to allow for a minimum of two weeks for processing. Apply online: <http://www.chamberlain.edu/admissions/undergraduate/bachelor-of-science-in-nursing>.
- **Admission Requirements**
  - Submit completed application and supporting documents, including official transcripts
  - Minimum high school cumulative GPA of 2.75 or minimum GED score of 551
  - Minimum college cumulative GPA of 2.75 – The college GPA must include a minimum of 24 credits, excluding developmental courses, from an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation. A college GPA achieved in the last 5 years may take precedence over a prior GPA. All transcripts must be submitted. Chamberlain uses transcribed GPA.
  - Minimum ACT composite of 21, minimum SAT critical reading and mathematics reasoning score of 990, or minimum A2 Admission Assessment score of 75.
  - All applicants for pre-licensure programs are required to complete the A2 Admissions Assessment test prior to admission. A student may retake the A2 Admission Assessment test only once after a three-day waiting period and within 30 days of submitting the Application for Admission at no charge. (A retesting fee will be)

- **Additional Information**
  - **Transfer Credit Evaluation:** Refer to recommended courses on this guide for approved articulated coursework. Other courses will be evaluated on an individual basis. Transfer credit generally is not awarded for coursework taken at another institution after initial enrollment at Chamberlain.
  - **Minimum Grade:** A minimum grade of C is required for all transfer coursework.
  - **Number of Credits Accepted from MCC:** 82 semester hours toward the 129 needed to complete the BSN; follow course recommendations outlined on this guide
  - **Proficiency Credit:** Credits may be recognized through nationally recognized tests such as AP, CLEP and DANES. Military educational history also may be recognized for proficiency credit.
