Such changes take precedence over the information on this guide. Students should work with an MCC advisor and the four-year transfer school. Responsibility for complying with all applicable requirements ultimately rests with the student.

### **Admission Information**

- Application and admission Students are strongly advised to study the ISU catalog and to consult with a counselor for specific admission and course requirements within the College of Nursing.
  - Application deadline Admission decisions are communicated on a rolling basis. Here are upcoming deadlines:
    - Fall start: August 1<sup>st</sup>
    - Spring start: December 15<sup>th</sup>
- Complete an ISU admission application which includes a Mennonite College of Nursing admission application
- Highest admission consideration is granted to transfer students with the strongest academic preparation. Cumulative GPA and progress toward completion of general education and major program degree requirements are the most important factors in admission decisions.
- Admission GPA calculation For repeat courses, ISU uses the most recent repeated grade for calculating admission GPA.
- Admission requirements
  - Graduate from state-approved diploma school of nursing or an associate degree nursing program
  - Licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Illinois (at time of admission students completing ADN in May must receive notification of passing Nursing Licensure Exam in order to start RN to BSN sequence in fall)
  - Minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA
  - Completion of Mennonite College of Nursing prerequisite courses with a C or better prior to the start of the fall semester (not at time of application): PSY151, PSY250, BIO255, BIO263, BIO264, HFE250 and a portion of IAI GECC (Communication) prior to the start of the fall semester; remainder of IAI GECC must be completed prior to graduation.
  - Completion of ISU AMALI and IDEAS requirements recommended prior to admission. Please see the transfer articulation guide for MCC located at <u>https://registrar.illinoisstate.edu/transfer/courses/</u> for courses that satisfy the aforementioned requirements. It is recommended that students find an AMALI or IDEAS course that also satisfies an IAI GECC course.
  - **Grade Requirement** With the exception of ENG151 and 152, ISU will accept the D grade for general education requirements. All prerequisite and major related courses require a minimum C grade.

### **Additional Information**

- Associate Degree nursing courses are "held in escrow" until successful completion of three ISU Nursing courses: NUR223, 227, and 236. Once completed with a C or greater, 34 credits are placed on the student's transcript for the following Nursing courses: NUR 229, 231, 314, 316, 317, and 325.
- Addition (2023) of the ISU 'IDEAS' requirement: Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Access in U.S. Society Requirement (IDEAS) – All students must complete a designated course designed to recognize the benefits and challenges of living in a

diverse society and to address the influence of power among social groups within the United States. IAI courses with a number ending with D will fulfill the requirement.

- The following options satisfy ISU's general education requirements for transfer students:
  - Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum (GECC Credential), including an AMALI and IDEAS course
  - An MCC AA degree or a bachelor's degree from a regional accredited institution, including an AMALI and IDEAS course (AS degree under 2015/16 or prior catalog)
