

## ILLINOIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER STUDENTS

### Articulation Agreements

Transfer students with an AA degree from an Illinois community college will enter the University of Iowa having fulfilled all General Education Program requirements in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Tippie College of Business, College of Education, and University College with the exception of:

- The respective World Language requirement for each UI college
  - Understanding Cultural Perspectives requirement for the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and Tippie College of Business

### Scholarships

#### Illinois Community College Opportunity Scholarship

*\$7,500 a year for up to two years*

For students who transfer to the University of Iowa within one year of earning their Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree. This scholarship is available to nonresident students who have only attended a community college in Illinois (no other four year institutions or community colleges outside of Illinois). Students completing their degree through one of Iowa's Distance Education or online programs are not eligible for this award.

Requires an Associate of Arts or Associate of Sciences degree from an Illinois community college AND a minimum 3.0 transfer GPA at the time of enrollment.

Eligible applicants must complete a University of Iowa Transfer Application by the following deadlines:

Fall Semester – May 1 | Spring Semester – November 1

#### Phi Theta Kappa:

*\$2,000 a year for up to 2 years*

For new entering community college transfer students who have earned 30 semester hours at the time of application, have maintained a minimum 3.50 cumulative transfer GPA (on a 4.0 scale), and are current members of the Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) International Honor Society. Students who have earned a bachelor's degree or are completing their degree through one of Iowa's Distance Education or online programs are not eligible for this award.

The PTK Application is available at our Iowa Scholarship Portal ([scholarships.uiowa.edu](https://scholarships.uiowa.edu)). Documentation of your PTK membership must be uploaded.

Fall semester – May 1 | Spring semester – December 1

## Admission Requirements

For admission to the University of Iowa transfer applicants:

- Must have a cumulative grade-point average (GPA) of 2.50 or higher on at least 24 semester hours earned after high school graduation (36 quarter hours) of acceptable graded credit, OR
- Students with fewer than 24 semester hours will be considered for admission based on a combination of high school and college academic records, as well as ACT or SAT scores.

**Students with fewer than 24 semester hours** will be considered for admission based on a combination of high school and college academic records, as well as ACT or SAT scores.

The above requirements are for admission into the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Other colleges may have additional pre-requisite requirements.
